

Results of first web poll: Tell us what you would like to see on this website.

121 votes were cast, identifying the following preferences:

19% want everything covered and are willing to help. Some of these have helped!

17% want in-depth coverage of all Alex School and community events

16% want in-depth coverage of Alex School activities such as academics, sports and ag activities.

14% want only general coverage as possible of Alex School and community activities.

13% want only to see lots of Alex names and faces.

9% want mainly academic information such as homework assignments, notes from teachers and academic achievements.

6% want only information about education in Oklahoma, including more career and college-bound information.

Second web poll: Who are our readers?

Over **100** votes were cast and, perhaps unsurprisingly, a full **30%** of respondents identified themselves as an Alex School graduate who is also the parent of an Alex School student.

16% of respondents were Alex students who read the website at home and at school.

14% of those participating in the poll were the parents of Alex school students who did not graduate from Alex School.

12% were students who do not have internet access at home and read the site only at school.

Another **12%** were teachers who visit the website at home and at school.

4% of respondents were Alex teachers who do not have internet access at home and read the site only at school. An additional **4%** were Alex community members. Yet another **4%** were people who are not associated with Alex School or the Alex community but are interested in Alex.

Finally, **3%** of those participating in the poll were students, teachers or parents from a school other than Alex.

Good News - We consider ourselves computer literate! Results of third web poll: At what level do you use the computer?

None of the almost **75** people who participated in this poll consider themselves real computer dummies. In fact, a full **50%** of respondents reported being regular internet users who built their own MySpace pages and were born with a mouse in their hand.

Unexpected: **22%** of those participating consider themselves computer power users.

Outstanding: **17%** of respondents reported that they regularly use many types of software and have a fairly good grasp of how computers work.

A little scary: **11%** of those participating in our poll dream in the Visual Basic computer programming language and can code web pages by hand!. Where are these people when you need 'em?

4th web poll - Do you have computers in your home?

The majority of those who participated in this survey (**31%**) share one family desktop or laptop with high speed internet access.

19% of respondents share two or more computers in their home connected by a wired or wireless home network.

15% of survey participants reported that everyone in their household has their own computer connected by a home network.

12% of those who participated in this survey share two or more non-networked computers in their home. Another 12% have at least one computer in their home but do not have internet access.

8% of respondents share one desktop or laptop with dialup internet access.

Finally, **4%** reported they did not have a computer but wanted one.
